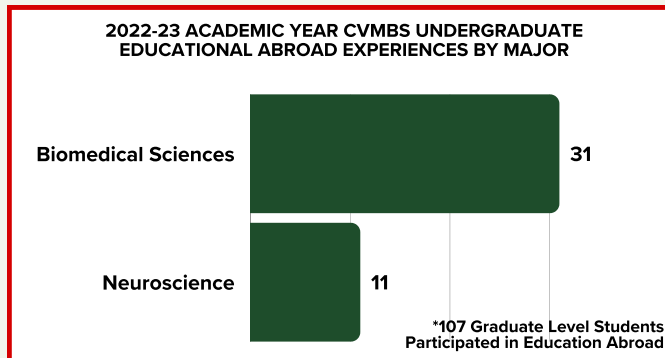
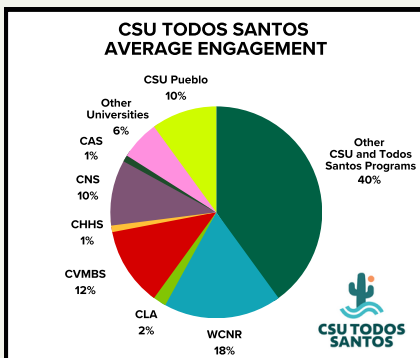
CVMBMS STAFF AND FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS
