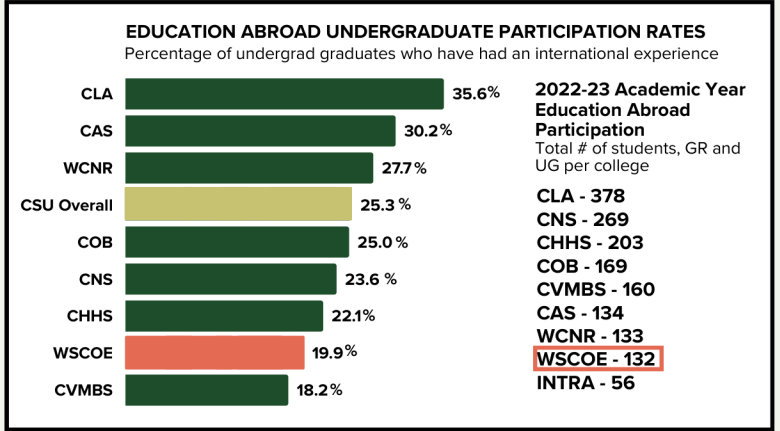
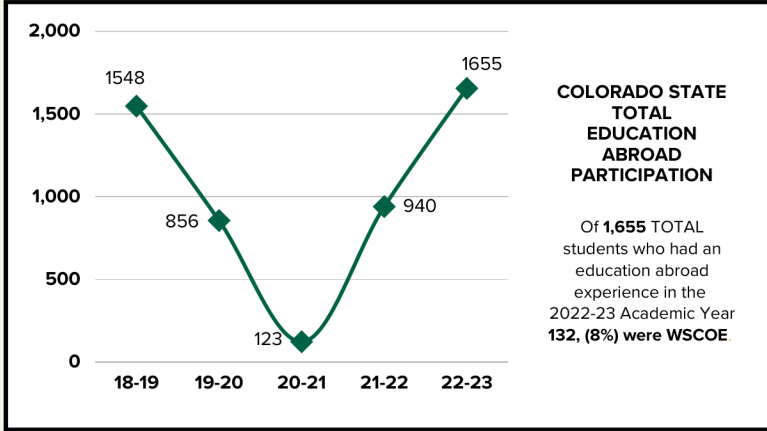
A summary of known global engagement activity for the 2022-23 Academic Year

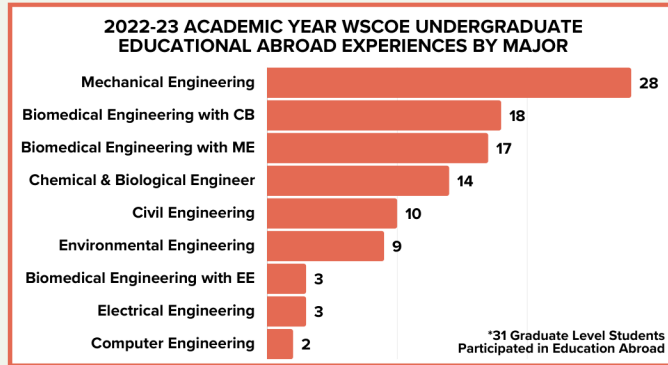
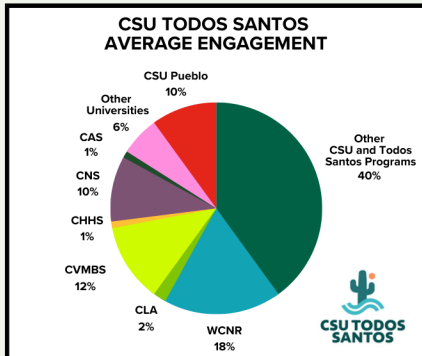
WSCOE STAFF AND FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS
