# Global Engagement Report

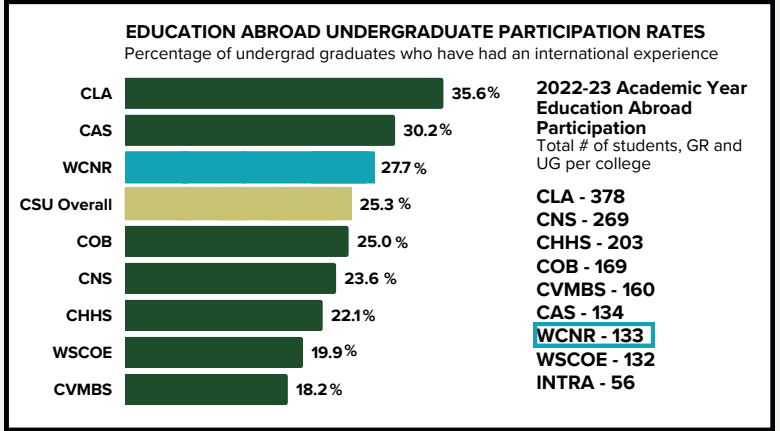
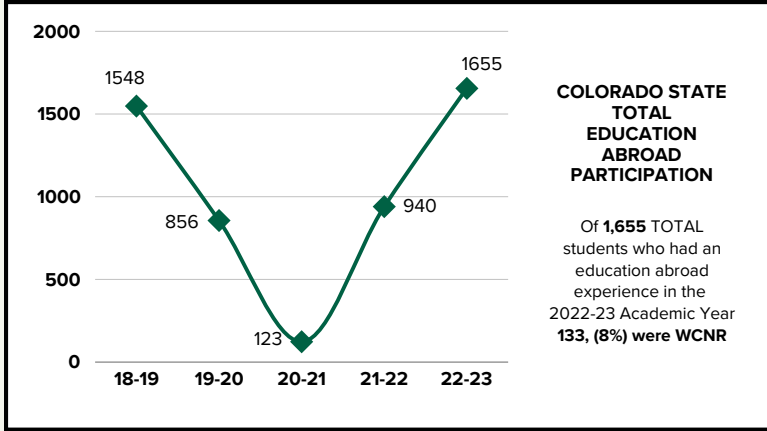
A summary of known global engagement activity for the 2022-23 Academic Year

**BRIDGE/FIRST YEAR SEMINARS**

Six more FYS programs for Fall 2024 are in the works.

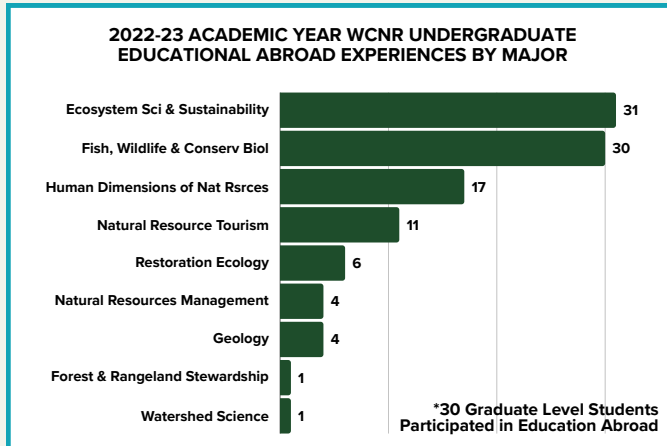
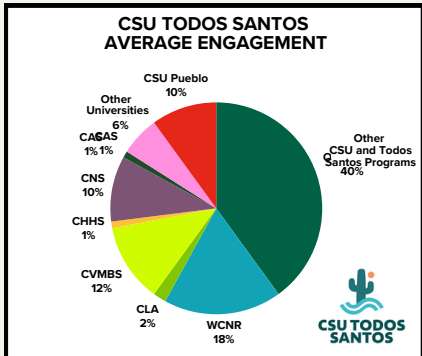
**WCNR STAFF AND FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS**
