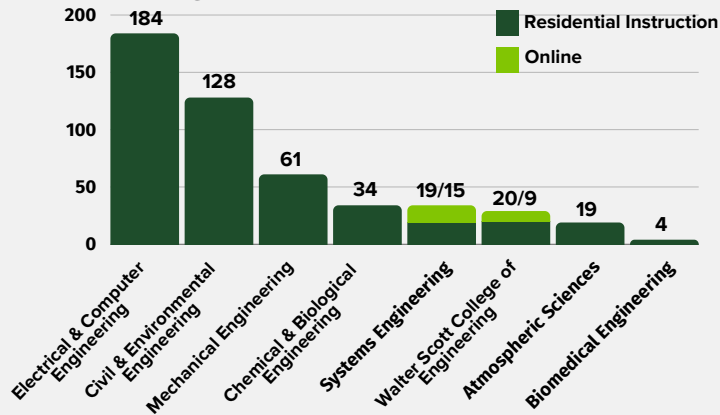

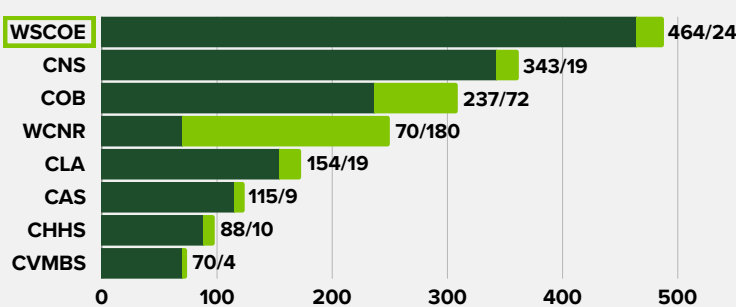

Colorado State University TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN

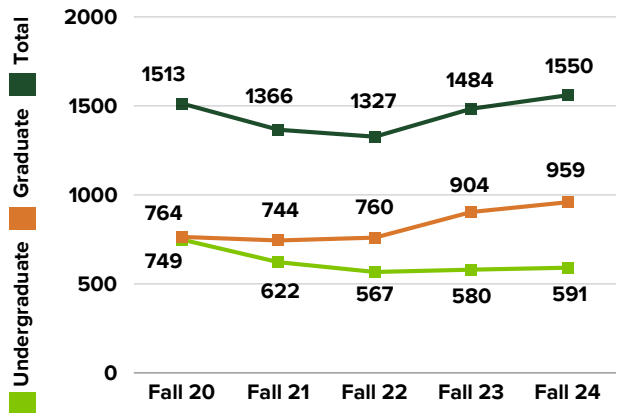
All international students in 2023-2024

Colorado State University TOTAL INTERNATIONAL ENROLLMENT

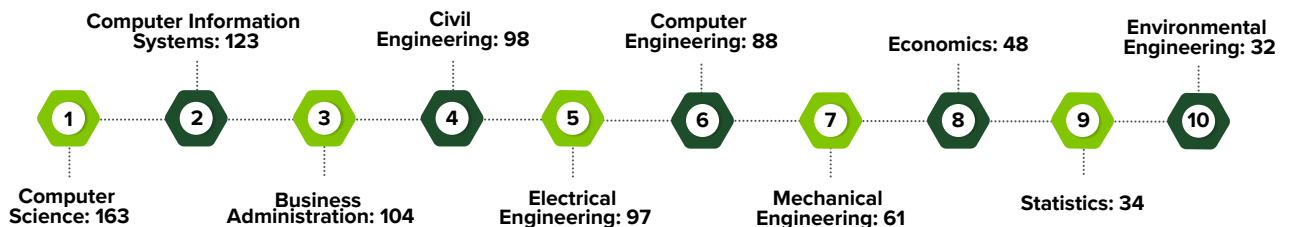

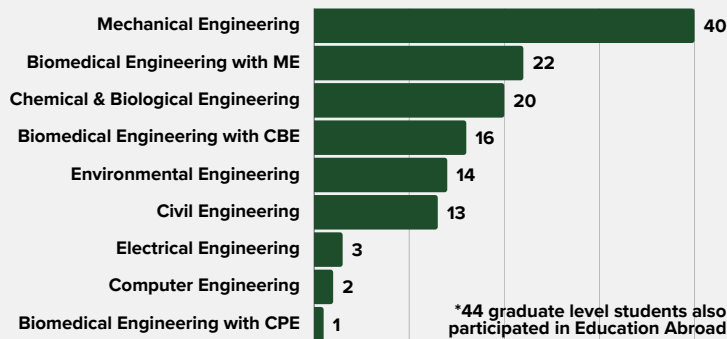

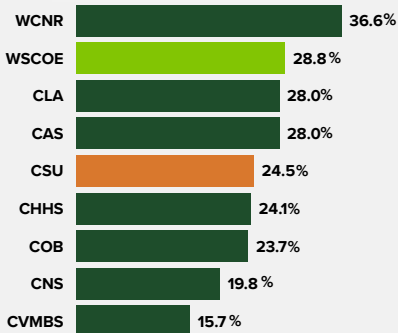

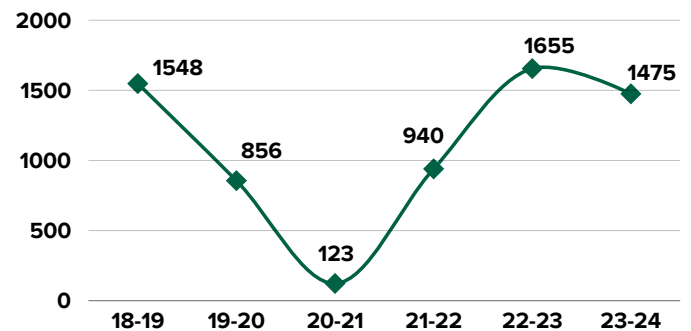
Colorado State University TOP 5 DESTINATIONS FOR EDUCATION ABROAD



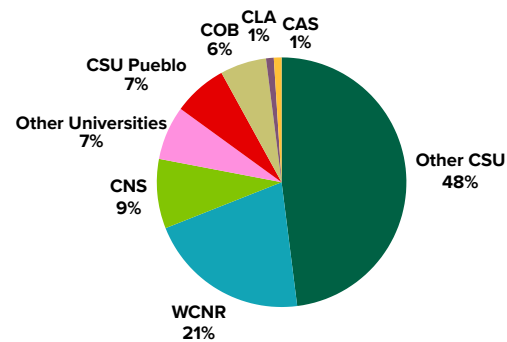
